

## Spelling Activities



Below are some activity ideas you can use to help you to learn your spellings each week. You only need to complete one activity per week and you may find that some activities help you to learn your spellings better than others.

<p><b>Silly Sentences</b></p> <p>Write silly sentences to make your teacher laugh. Include and underline your spelling words.</p>	<p><b>Rainbow Words</b></p> <p>Write your words in at least four different colours.</p>	<p><b>Alphabetical Spaghetti</b></p> <p>Put your words in alphabetical order!</p>
<p><b>Amazing Stories</b></p> <p>Write a short story using ALL of the spelling words. The funnier and whackier the better! Underline all your spelling words using a ruler.</p>	<p><b>Magazine Letters</b></p> <p>Cut out letters from a magazine/newspaper and glue them together to make your spelling words.</p>	<p><b>Pictionary</b></p> <p>Draw pictures on separate pieces of scrap paper to show the MEANING of the words. See if your friends or family can guess the word from your drawings.</p>
<p><b>Bingo</b></p> <p>You need to have at least one other person to do this one. Draw a 3x3 table and write this week's spelling words in any order. Take turns to call out the words. The winner is the first one with 5 words crossed out.</p>	<p><b>Air Write</b></p> <p>Write the spelling words from the list with your body. You can use different body parts like hands, head or legs to spell the different words.</p>	<p><b>Word Puzzle</b></p> <p>Use the word with the most letters in your list and make as many other words as you can using those letters. Then try with another word from the list.</p>
<p><b>UPPER and Lower</b></p> <p>Write your spelling words out twice, once in UPPER case letters and once in lower case letters.</p>	<p><b>Fancy Letters</b></p> <p>Write each of your words using fancy writing, you could try curly, joined up, dotted, block letters, whatever you like!</p>	<p><b>Forwards and Backwards</b></p> <p>Write your words forwards and then try to write them backwards!</p>
