Below is a list of some activities and useful website links for you to complete whilst you are off school. Please upload any learning to Tapestry.

Maths

- Draw a 2D shape picture of a rocket/ alien.
- Practice counting to 20 and back down again.
- Find one more and one less of numbers to 20.
- Add and subtract two numbers up to 20 e.g. $8 - 6 = 2$
 $5 + 5 = 10$, $15 + 3 = 18$, $20 - 2 = 18$ etc.

Reading

- Practice sounding out and blending the nonsense words that were put in your homework books previously.
- Read your school book/ books at home.
- Read a range of books that you have at home – fiction, non-fiction, comics etc.
- Read any labels/ signs that you can see at home.

Writing

- Write three sentences describing the different planets in space. Remember to use a capital letter, finger spaces and full stops.
- Carry out some research about space and find out some interesting facts. Write these down in your homework books.
- Draw an astronaut and label their outfit/ body parts.

Topic

- Make your own space station/ planet using the resources you have at home.
- Create rockets using lego and measure to discover which one is the longest/ shortest.
- Make up a song about space.
- Create some cookies in the shape of a rocket/ alien.
