Dear Parent / Carer,

As advised in our remote learning guidance letter, please find enclosed the Year 3 work pack for your use. This is work which is in line with work we are covering in the classroom and supports the development and progress of the children.

Maths

In Maths this term we are working in recognising place value in numbers to 1000, counting on and back in 1s, 10s and 100s from any number and addition and subtraction skills. In this pack you will find work which focuses on all of these three areas. Please complete place value and counting work first, before moving on to addition and subtraction. For anyone who wants an extra challenge, there are some missing number addition and subtraction problems included as well.

Also included are times tables activity pages as we are constantly working on these throughout the year.

English

In English we will be working on narrative writing until the end of term. Please find enclosed some activities which will help you with your narrative writing. First there is a character situation activity looking at our story: The Stone Age Boy; secondly you will find a character description activity; and finally you will find a narrative planning guide for planning your own historical narrative. If you have completed all three activities you can have a go at writing your own narrative set in the Stone Age.

Reading

Please continue to read your school books regularly. In addition, we are looking at comprehension around Stone Age based texts. To support with this, two Stone Age themed comprehensions are included.

GPaS

In GPaS this term, we are focussing on adjectives and adverbs. The activities enclosed will help children to revise these areas.

Phonics

Please find enclosed a set of Phase 3 sounds with words to learn to read and write and a Phase 5 set of sounds with words to learn to read and write.

Topic

As you know, we are studying the Stone Age in our topic. Please find enclosed some activities linked with our topic. In addition to these, please feel free to do any additional research, particularly around the Neolithic era, or perhaps if you are feeling creative you could make a Mesolithic headdress or a Weetabix Stonehenge!

Science

In Science this term, we are studying nutrition and the skeleton. Please find enclosed activities about key food groups, creating a healthy diet plan and recognising the parts of the skeleton.

RE

In RE this term, we have been learning about Judaism. Please find enclosed two activities which will enable your child to learn more about two parts of Judaism, the Torah and Shabbat, which we will be discussing in class. You may need to do some research to help you complete these activities.

PSHE

In PSHE this term, we have been looking at friendships and relationships with others. In addition to this, we have also been talking a lot about how to keep ourselves safe at this time. Included is a Carex hand hygiene pack with three activities to explore hand hygiene with your child.

In a school day, we would expect children to complete a Maths, English, Reading and GPaS or phonics activity along with one or two foundation subject activities depending on the length of the task. Please try to maintain a similar timetable at home.

Please complete the work which is at the appropriate level for your child, we do not expect all children to complete all the work in this pack. If you have any questions, please contact us.
